**PENTECOST - TODAY.** It falls on the 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Easter each year. On this day  
we celebrate the giving of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the Church! Pentecost  
comes from a Greek word meaning "fiftieth." The Festival was originally the Jewish  
Feast of Weeks, which occurred 50 days after the Passover (Deut. 16:10). During this  
festival, the Holy Spirit descended upon the first disciples, with the sound of a rushing  
wind and in tongues of fire above their heads. They were filled with the Holy Spirit  
and empowered to preach the Gospel with boldness. On the first Pentecost, 3,000 people  
became followers of Jesus due to the Apostles' preaching. There are many Pentecost  
traditions. At the Village church we use red balloons to remind us of the tongues  
of fire.
