INCLINE VILLAGE SMALL GROUP meets on Tuesday evenings at the Ferrell's home. Contact Tim Gilbert for more information.

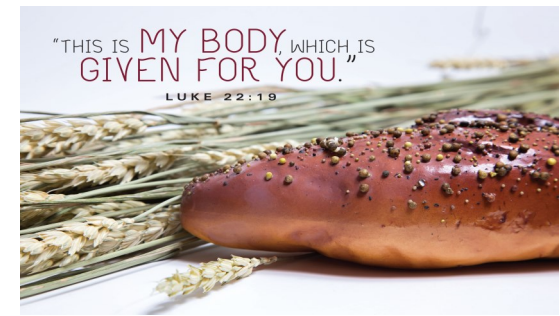
WEDNESDAY EVENING BIBLE STUDY meets at 6:00pm in the Fireside Room for discussion of the Sunday sermon. All are welcome.
