STORY BEHIND THE NEW SONG FACING A TASK UNFINISHED. This hymn was first penned by China Inland Mission worker, Frank Houghton, at a time when persecution in China was at its height. In 1929, the Lord laid a vision on the heart of CIM leaders to see 200 new workers plunge into the darkness and share the light of Christ, knowing that it could well cost them their lives. As he reflected on Jesus' words in Matthew 24:14 to bear the torch of the Gospel to all the nations, his heart was broken for the people of China, and he wrote:

"Facing a task unfinished, that drives us to our knees. A need that, undiminished, rebukes our slothful ease. We, who rejoice to know Thee, renew before Thy throne, the solemn pledge we owe Thee to go and make Thee known."

By 1932, the last of the 200 missionaries had set sail for China to spread the good news of the Gospel. Since that time, the church of China has grown to millions who claim Christ as their Lord, and the Lord continues to work in great ways because of the faithfulness of those that gave their lives proclaiming that Jesus died and rose.

Kristyn and Keith Getty are delighted to introduce this hymn about missions to a new generation. They pray it will be an anthem for rising up to face the unfinished task and going to the entire world to proclaim salvation in Jesus' name.
