


From Pastor Jeff

"Men of Israel, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know. This man was handed over to you by God's set purpose and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross. But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him...God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of the fact...Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." Acts 2:22-36

For the people of God in Jesus' day, the chief qualification of the Messiah was to be a conquering hero who would rescue them from their enemies. That Jesus' ministry seemingly ended in his crucifixion and death would have be a clear sign to the Jewish people that he was **not** the Messiah. The Messiah was supposed to destroy the Romans, not be beaten and killed by them. When Peter stands up on the day of Pentecost to explain the truth about Jesus, he focuses on the Resurrection, showing that it was God's seal of approval on Jesus' ministry. Jesus came to defeat our real enemies, sin, death, and the devil. On the cross he atones for the sins of his people, and disarms the power of the devil. In the Resurrection he overcomes death and opens the way to eternal life for all who believe. Because of the Resurrection, we know that Jesus' sacrifice is accepted by the Father and that Jesus' ministry was true. Because of the Resurrection, we know we can trust the words of the apostles recorded in the New Testament. Because of the Resurrection, we can have confidence in Jesus and in his word.

So this Easter give thanks for God's acceptance of Jesus and his ministry and for the reality of salvation in his name.


MAUNDY THURSDAY SERVICE APRIL 18TH

- Saturday, April 6th from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.: Food box distribution. We can use help hosting applicants and loading food boxes into cars.




JOIN OUR CHOIR



for a time of learning more and going deeper into the Bible.




CHURCH OFFICE HOURS
