From Pastor Jeff

"[H]e said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me." 2 Corinthians 12:9

I'm still processing my experiences on the Youth Mission Trip to San Francisco. I saw things there I had never seen before. People living in the grip of drug and alcohol addiction, in great poverty and sickness. It's a lot to take in. It seems almost surreal that places like the Tenderloin and the North Shore of Lake Tahoe can be found on the same planet. I definitely felt out of place and way outside my comfort zone the week-long experience.

I knew I would, and that is why I went. I have discovered that my faith in Jesus doesn't grow if I play it safe all the time. I must put myself in places where I must depend on God if I want to grow in faith. In this respect, spiritual health is like physical health. You must work out and push yourself if you want to grow stronger muscles. Your spiritual muscles need a work out, too! Growing in grace or sanctification requires effort on our part. If we always play it safe, only talk to safe people, only go where we feel comfortable, we stay soft in our faith. But if we are willing to take risks for Jesus, to start conversations with people, to share the Gospel—well, then our faith grows because we find God able to meet our needs in our weakness.

If you are feeling stale in your faith, if God is seeming a little distant, a little unreal or flat, I encourage you to get out of your comfort zone and do something for the Kingdom, something you are not certain about. William Carey, the founder of the modern missions movement, said, "Expect great things from God; attempt great things for God." If we do, we'll find we have a great God!








ALOHA SUNDAY

YUMMY SALAD DRESSING RECIPE




