#### From Pastor Jeff

Why is there a church? Why do we exist? What is our mission? Knowing our mission would definitely make it easier to accomplish.

The first thing to note is that the church is a people not a place. The New Testament word we translate as "church" is *ekklesia*. It means "assembly." We talk about "going to church", but this is just a shorthand way of saying, "Going to the place where the church assembles." Wherever God's people assemble, there is the church.



As the people of God, we have a mission, to be fulfilled individually and corporately. Jesus laid out our mission in these words:

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.

As God's people, our mission is to love God with all of our beings and care for our neighbors the way we care for ourselves.

How do we love God? He tells us: Believe in Jesus (John 12:44-46, 1 John 3:23) and obey his commands (John 14:15, 23; 1 John 5:3; see also John 15:9-14) How do we care for our neighbor? By showing mercy, forgiveness, understanding, and by being compassionate, speaking the truth in love, providing for those without food, shelter, clothing and taking care of physical and spiritual needs. This mission is worked out corporately as we fulfill the Great Commission, recorded in Matthew 28:18-20 (see also Mark 16:15-16, Luke 24:45-48, John 21:30-31):

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

The ultimate love we show to God and the World is when we tell the Good News that Jesus is Lord and has overcome sin and death and that all who trust in him will be forgiven and receive eternal life. We proclaim this Good News by our actions as well as by telling the story of how God saved us. Read the very first sermon preached by the newly born church, Peter's sermon on Pentecost. It's found in Acts 2:14-41.

Listen to the climax of Peter's message:

"Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"

Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off-- for all whom the Lord our God will call."

With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation."

Peter's concern is that people would believe in Jesus and be saved. It must be our concern as well. To truly love God we must seek him, desire him, obey him and to truly love our neighbors is to desire that they share with us the joy of eternal life. This is our mission; this is why the church exists, so that those who don't know Jesus, may be found by him and that the world may know that Jesus is Lord.








## PRAY &-GA

#### **Operation Christmas Child**

A Project of Samaritan's Purse A "Shoebox" Ministry

Samaritan's Purse is an evangelical Christian organization providing spiritual and physical aid to hurting people around the world: victims of war, poverty, natural disasters, disease and famine, while providing the soul-saving Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Operation Christmas Child is directed to the most vulnerable of these needy people- the children- in the tangible form of a shoe box filled with gifts of simple toys, personal items and hygiene items along with easy-to-read tract "The Greatest Gift", which colorfully tells of hope and Jesus' love for them in their native language.

This simple idea has blossomed over thirty years, through God's grace and the work of participating evangelical churches, to reach out to over 130 countries with distribution of tens of millions of gift shoe boxes. More importantly the shoe boxes have included the Gospel message that has turned so many young lives to Christ.

Here at the Village Church we are designated as a central depot in this area for collection of shoe boxes in the third week of November for further distribution around the world.

The mechanics are fun and simple. We have supplies of the shoe boxes in plastic and card board. Just fill the shoe box with items for either boy or girl of age category 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. Most importantly, as you are packing, pray for the boy or girl recipient who will receive your gift.

(Since my birthday is in November I ask all six of my grandchildren to pack a shoe box and pray for the recipient in lieu of giving Grandpa a present).

Include a personal note and picture if you like. Suggested gift items include:

#### **School supplies**

**Hygiene items**: combs, tooth brush, bar soap, wash cloth, etc.

**Toys:** balls, kazoo, harmonica, puzzles, yo-yo, dolls, etc.

**Personal items:** T-shirt, hats, hair clips, sun glasses, socks, flashlights with batteries No food, liquids, knives, & breakable items, etc.

Think of the joy this will bring to kids, many of whom have never received a gift of any kind in their lives.




