


From Pastor Jeff

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION January 2019

In January and February, Preschool and Elementary Sunday school classes will learn that God is merciful and allows new beginnings when we commit ourselves to Him. This is a great series of lessons for the New Year!

Lesson 1 - Chance After Chance

In the first lesson, the children will learn how much God loves them, as He offers them the gift of salvation through Jesus from whom they can receive new beginnings. "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9. Children will learn how many times we should forgive each other. How many times does God want us to forgive the same person?

This is a new year. Each week is a new week, each day is a new day and each hour is a new hour. We can come to our Father in Heaven through His Son and ask for forgiveness as often as needed. When we are truly repentant, God will forgive us an unlimited amount of times because His mercy and love is unlimited. When we truly repent, and are sorry for our sin, and Jesus' sacrifice on the cross will allow for us to be cleansed from our sin.

Lesson 2 - I Choose The New

In this lesson, the children will discuss and discover how to get rid of the old and put on the new by being in Christ. "Put off your old self... put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness." Ephesians 4:22, 24. Children will learn about why we are to take off the old and put on the new and how we can do that.

After this lesson, the hope is that each child will walk away feeling a little more like God and less like his or her old self. Only we are responsible for getting rid of old bad habits, sinful ways, evil thoughts, etc. No one else can decide to get rid of them but us. We must ask the Holy Spirit to help get rid of old ways and put on the new creation.

Lesson 3 - Let Go and Let God

This lesson focuses on Love, Trust, and Wonder. "In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps." Proverbs 16:9. No matter how much we plan there are things that happen unexpectedly that are out of our control. God is in ultimate control. In many cases, we plan, but then there are situations that we must let go and let God show up and do the work. Trust that He will get us through whatever obstacle is in front of us.

As humans we ask ourselves many questions trying to figure out the future. We think: What teacher will I get this year? Who will be my friend? What sport will I play? What type of job will I have when I grow up? Who will I marry?

These are just a few questions that are very common to wonder. Yet, as we wonder, God already knows. Our job is to plan and commit ourselves to God and He will guide us to the perfect promise He has for us. It's not going to be easy, stress free, or pain free. For God said we will have trials in this world, but as we trust in Him and commit to Him, His purpose for us will prevail.



Thanks for being the hands and feet of Jesus!




DEACONS NEWS


