




From Pastor Jeff

THE BIBLE AS ONE CONTINUING STORY OF GOD AND HIS PEOPLE



We are hoping to reverse this trend here at The Village Church. Starting on January 21st we will begin "The Story," a campaign designed to help us understand the Bible, God's story, from Genesis to Revelation. "The Story" is made up of 31 chapters of carefully selected scriptures sequenced in chronological order. It presents the Bible in an engaging format, reading like a novel. Most importantly, "The Story" campaign will help us see how our stories intersect with God's.

The Story Church Campaign is a program providing 31 weeks of curriculum for children, teen and adults and 31 weeks of corresponding sermons. When accompanied by reading through the age-related books of "The Story," our entire church can be literally on the same page for 31 weeks.

The books have been purchased and are available starting in January. Please consider committing to reading your way thru The Story, joining a small group to go deeper, and inviting a friend who may have questions about the Bible. 




gage with it more easily. Entering into God's story in creative and meaningful ways is an important piece of the spiritual formation of children, youth, and adults. This curriculum is a wonderful tool for introducing all ages to the amazing stories of God's entry into the lives of men and women, reminding them that God is in the midst of their lives too.

The Story curriculum for preschoolers is designed to engage young children in the bible through movement, simple songs, and other activities using the five senses, in a way that will hold their attention and aid in retention. Each preschool lesson includes two teaching/learning activities other than the Bible story. The first is called "Come Together." Each of these activities is designed to capture and focus the child's attention on the theme and the Bible story of the day. The "Come Together" activities help the children ease into the lesson time and separate from what they were doing prior to the class beginning. Each lesson includes several "Explore More" activities, which are to be used after the Bible story has been told. These activities are designed to help young children enter into a part of the Bible story in an active and creative way.

CORNER

The lessons in the curriculum for elementary-age children are divided into several parts. The Bible stories are designed to be told interactively and to help the children enter and engage in the Bible story in a creative and active way. After the Bible story is finished, children are directed back to "Hear the Story" activities to help them debrief the Bible story together. Each lesson begins with the "Come Together"




learning activity, which is designed to focus the children's attention on the point and the facts of the Bible story. After the Bible story is told, elementary children are also invited into "Explore More" activities.

Christian parents want to nurture their children in God's stories in the Bible but often feel they don't know how. The Story curriculum includes a Parents' Page for each lesson, which offers parents ideas for interacting with their entire family around the week's Bible story. The points for the Bible story are included, and families are given "Table Talk" questions that can be adapted for each age level. These questions can be used to explore the Bible story at the dinner table, in the car, or at any time when the family is together. Each Parents' Page also includes a "Living the Faith" activity: a game, art project, or other fun activity the whole family can engage in. Also included is an "Extra Mile" activity for those families who still crave more learning activities around the week's Bible story. You can read more about The Story at **thestory.com**
