From Pastor Jeff

I think about the Fourth of July in a few days, the words of an old Rich Mullins song "Land of My Sojourn," keep coming to mind:

"Nobody tells you when you get born here
How much you'll come to love it
And how you'll never belong here
So I call you my country
And I'll be lonely for my home"

I am reminded that as much as I love my country, I'll never really belong here because I am just a sojourner. A sojourner is a biblical word for someone who is away from home and living in a foreign land. This word is can be translated alien, stranger, exile, foreigner, temporary resident, pilgrim. Abraham and the other patriarchs were sojourners as they traveled about the land of Canaan with no permanent residence, just a burial plot near Hebron (see Gen 23:4 and 47:9). They were waiting for the country promised by God. Even when Israel entered the Promised Land, God made it clear that they were still to consider themselves sojourners. God tells them that "[Y]ou are only aliens and temporary residents on my land. (Lev. 25:23). In 1 Chronicles 29:15, King David speaks of all Israel as "aliens and strangers in [God's] sight, as were all our forefathers. Our days on earth are like a shadow, without hope." The New Testament authors pick up this idea thinking about the Christian life. The author of Hebrews, speaking of the example of the patriarchs says, "All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them and welcomed them from a distance. And they admitted that they were strangers and aliens on earth." (Hebrews 11:13) and Peter says, "conduct yourselves with reverence throughout the time of your sojourn," (1 Pet. 1:17) and "Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul." (1 Pet. 2:11)

I love my country, but this motif of the sojourning people of God reminds me that in Christ I have received a new, permanent citizenship. I belong to the Kingdom of God. "Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth...remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ...Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens [sojourners], but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household (Eph. 2:11-13, 19). I'm not looking for a perfect home here on earth but with Abraham and the rest of the people of God, I am "longing for a better country-- a heavenly one. (Heb. 11:16) and "looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God." (Heb. 11:10) So celebrate our country this week but remember where you are headed in Christ.

ALL CHURCH BBQ AT INCLINE BEACH


Saturday, July 20th

SAMARITAN'S PURSE A CHRISTIAN DISASTER RELIEF ORGANIZATION

Samaritan's Purse is one of the Christian mission organizations The Village Church supports. It was founded by Bob Pierce in 1970, and Franklin Graham became president in 1979.

The organization's **mission** is to meet the spiritual and physical needs of people suffering from war, poverty, disaster, disease, and famine. The organization serves Christ's church worldwide by propagating the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ through emergency relief efforts. It specializes in providing shelter, sanitation, food and medical care. As Franklin Graham states, the organization "runs to, not away from" natural and man-made disasters around the world.

Samaritan's Purse **ministries** include practical, emotional and spiritual relief following both natural and man-made disasters, child relief and care, and special operations (see below). The organization was deeply involved in meeting the Ebola crisis in West Africa in 2014, and it currently operates hospitals in the conflict areas of South Sudan and northern Iraq.

The organization has full-time administrative and project staff, but most of its ministries are carried out by volunteers who clean out and rebuild homes and churches damaged by flooding or fires as well as serve in the medical facilities overseas. In every situation the volunteers doing the hard labor are supported by trained chaplains who minister "in the name of Jesus" to the disaster victims as well as to the staff and volunteers.

The Village Church has for a number of years supported various Samaritan's Purse ministries.

We participate annually in "Operation Christmas Child" which organizes thousands of churches, schools, groups and individual donors to prepare and collect shoeboxes filled with toys, school supplies, personal items, and other small gifts. A booklet of Bible stories is distributed alongside the shoebox gifts which are given to children based on need alone, regardless of their faith. Our church plans to participate again this year; details will follow later.

Our church also has sent two teams of volunteers to support the rebuilding of flooded homes in Texas after Hurricane Harvey, and individuals from our church have served with Samaritan's Purse in other disaster relief efforts in various US locations.

Our Women's Ministry has provided financial support to "Operation Heal Our Patriots" (OHOP), an effort by Samaritan's Purse to save the marriages of wounded veterans. Some of our members have served at the Samaritan's OHOP Lodge in Alaska.

We invite you to consider serving with Samaritan's Purse either on one of our future church teams or individually. Please contact the church office if you would like to speak to someone for more information.

Also, we recommend two books which provide more background on Samaritan's Purse: <u>Bob Pierce - This One Thing I Do</u> by Graham and Lockerbie, and <u>Rebel With A Cause</u> by Franklin Graham. CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Vacation Bible School

Saddle up your horses and get on over to SonWest Roundup! This August we'll discover a colorful old town where all the excitement of the Wild West awaits! In SonWest, we'll celebrate all the fun of being buckaroos! Ride with

us as we head out through this bright wilderness—we're traveling down the trail through the Old Testament

stories of Moses to discover God's ultimate plan of salvation in Jesus, because "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever" (Hebrews 13:8).

We will be hosting ages 3 to 11 altogether in the same week this year. Children will be broken out by age into their respective groups and stations. The PreK stations are: Pony Corral (similar to the sensory station on the patio in the past), PreK Craft, PreK Bible Story. The Elementary age stations are: Elementary craft, Memory Verse with game, Bible Story. There will also be snacks and opening/closing songs with a skit each day. We also need volunteers to serve ice cream the last day of VBS.

Day 1 - Ultimate Plan

In Session 1, we'll saddle up as God's Ultimate Plan is revealed! We will discover that just as God had a plan to free the Israelites and sent Moses to deliver them from slavery in Egypt, He sent Jesus to deliver us from the slavery of sin. Kids will learn John 3:16, where Jesus describes God's astounding plan of salvation!

Day 2 - Ultimate Power

In Session 2, we'll giddy up to discover that Ultimate Power is found in Jesus! We will discover that just as God showed His power to Moses at the burning bush, so He showed His mighty power to us through Jesus' life and miracles. In a world of big problems and huge crises, we'll find that Jesus' power is stronger than anything! Our Bible verse is John 16:33, where Jesus reminds us that He has overcome the world!





Day 3 - Ultimate Rescue

In Session 3, we'll ride out with the Israelites in the Ultimate Rescue! We'll hear how God rescued His people from slavery in Egypt—even saving them from death! And we'll discover salvation and life forever with Jesus, made possible through His death and resurrection. The Bible verse is John 11:25, where Jesus tells that He is the resurrection and the life and that those who believe in Him will live forever with Him.

Day 4 - Ultimate Trust

In Session 4, we will head up to explore Ultimate Trust! We will learn how God provided for His people in the desert—and how Jesus provides for us every day, in every way! Kids will memorize John 6:35 and discover that we can trust Jesus to always provide what we need!





Day 5 - Ultimate Love

In Session 5, we'll round up to find Ultimate Love! As we hear about the time when Moses received God's commands at Mount Sinai, we will also discover that Jesus gave a new command. We'll see how loving Jesus means following His example and caring about others in our words as actions as He would. The Bible verse is John 13:34-35, Jesus' new commandment, given to His dearest friends—and to us.

Men's Bible Study -Wednesdays at 6:30 a.m.






