From Pastor Jeff

In thinking about the Fourth of July this Sunday the words of an old Rich Mullins song "Land of My Sojourn," keep coming to mind:

"Nobody tells you when you get born here. How much you'll come to love it
And how you'll never belong here. So I call you my country
And I'll be lonely for my home"

I am reminded that as much as I love my country, I'll never really belong here because I am just a sojourner. A sojourner is a biblical word for someone who is away from home and living in a foreign land. This word is can be translated alien, stranger, exile, foreigner, temporary resident, pilgrim. Abraham and the other patriarchs were sojourners as they traveled about the land of Canaan with no permanent residence, just a burial plot near Hebron (see Gen 23:4 and 47:9). They were waiting for the country promised by God. Even when Israel entered the Promised Land, God made it clear that they were still to consider themselves sojourners. God tells them that "[Y]ou are only aliens and temporary residents on my land. (Lev. 25:23). In 1 Chronicles 29:15, King David speaks of all Israel as "aliens and strangers in [God's] sight, as were all our forefathers. Our days on earth are like a shadow, without hope." The New Testament authors pick up this idea thinking about the Christian life. The author of Hebrews, speaking of the example of the patriarchs says, "All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them and welcomed them from a distance. And they admitted that they were strangers and aliens on earth." (Hebrews 11:13) and Peter says, "conduct yourselves with reverence throughout the time of your sojourn," (1 Pet. 1:17) and "Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul." (1 Pet. 2:11)

I love my country, but this motif of the sojourning people of God reminds me that in Christ I have received a new, permanent citizenship. I belong to the Kingdom of God. "Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth...remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ...Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens [sojourners], but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household (Eph. 2:11-13, 19). I'm not looking for a perfect home here on earth but with Abraham and the rest of the people of God, I am "longing for a better country-- a heavenly one. (Heb. 11:16) and "looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God." (Heb. 11:10) So celebrate our country this weekend but remember where you are headed in Christ.

COFFEE/FELLOWSHIP HOUR


Sundays following the 10AM ServiceCoffee/fellowship

VOM strives to inspire believers to deepen their commitment to Christ and to fulfill His Great Commission — no matter the cost.

VOM's mission around the world is to:

Encourage and empower Christians to fulfill the Great Commission in areas of the world where they are persecuted for sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Provide practical relief and spiritual support to the families of Christian martyrs. Pray for and equip persecuted Christians to love and win to Christ those who are opposed to the gospel in their part of the world.

Undertake projects of encouragement, helping believers rebuild their lives and Christian witness in countries where they have formerly suffered oppression.

Promote the fellowship of all believers by informing the world of the faith and courage of persecuted Christians, thereby inspiring believers to a deeper level of commitment to Christ and involvement in His Great Commission.

Each month VOM publishes a short magazine that provides the opportunity to:

Learn the truth about Christian persecution, such as in China, India, North Korea, Nigeria, etc., and read about our persecuted Christian brothers and sisters Be moved and encouraged by the testimonies of those persecuted and learn how to pray for them.

In addition to its monthly magazine, VOM produces the following resources to help Christians learn about and support persecuted brothers and sisters:


