
From Pastor Jeff

One of the first things that got me interested in the Bible as a kid were the maps. Maps of the journeys of Abraham, the Exodus, Jesus' itinerant ministry all over Galilee and Judea, and, of course, maps of Paul's missionary journeys. Biblical faith has always been a missionary religion, a "going" faith. We even talk about our "walk" with the Lord or "following" Jesus. The very last commands of Jesus to his people are commands to "Go and make disciples" and to be his "witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. (Acts 1:8) If we are to be at all sincere in our claim to be followers of Jesus, we must be individuals who are going to the world with the Good News of Jesus.

Now one the major problems of modern American life, and American Christianity, is that we are far too sedentary. It is not good for our waistlines or our faith to be couch potatoes! VILLAGE CHURCH MISSIONS



Samaritan's Purse - A Christian Disaster Relief Organization

Founded in 1865, The Salvation Army, an international movement, is an evangelical part of the universal Christian Church. Its message is based on the Bible. Its ministry is motivated by the love of God. Its mission is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in His name without discrimination. They help approximately 23 million Americans annually and serve in 130 countries around the globe.

The Reno Corps of the Salvation Army works to fulfill the mission of the greater organization from their headquarters on Sutro Street in Reno. They provide social services such as utility, rental and shelter assistance, a food pantry, clothing and furniture vouchers, as well as dental, vision and prescription programs. They

also operate an adult rehabilitation program for men ages 18-62. The 26-week program has 70 beds available and is offered free of charge. The local organization also responds when tragedy strikes by providing emergency disaster services. Whether it is a house fire, or a natural disaster on a greater scale, the Salvation Army is there to provide for physical needs and offer emotional support. Every Sunday there is a worship service offered at their location.

Funding for the Reno Corps comes not only from the familiar "red kettle" drive during Christmas season and donors like The Village Church, they have three thrift stores in the Reno/Carson City area. Proceeds from the thrift stores fund the rehabilitation program, and the men in the program receive work therapy by picking up donations and preparing them for sale.

Jose Silonxochitl, the Director of Social Services for the Salvation Army Reno Corps, reported that there has been a steady increase over the last 3-5 years in the level of need they see in their rental assistance program. In 2020, the demand tripled, with an increasing need seen in the Spanish-speaking community. Thankfully, the Reno program has Spanish speakers, and they were able to assist hundreds of clients. Their food assistance program experienced fluctuations in not only need related to COVID, but also in available methods to meet those needs and the level of comfort the clients had in visiting their locations for food assistance. In 2021 they are seeing an increase in people coming to them for food assistance.

During COVID there has been an adverse effect on the rehabilitation program. According to Reverend W. Wade Furlong, Chaplain/Director of Rehabilitation Services, the number of applications to the program has been declining due to the number of short-term programs and half-way houses available. The good news is that the increase in the number of entry-level jobs in the community may be helping those in need find employment; the bad news is that they may not be dealing with their addiction issues.

The need is great in the Reno-Sparks area for all of the services provided by the Reno Corps of The Salvation Army. The Village Church Missions Committee is grateful to have the resources to support their ministry. Please keep their employees and those they serve in your prayers.


