"Abide in me, and I and you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I and him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing." John 15:4-5

Here in John chapter 15 Jesus gives us the key commands to the Christian life. Jesus commands us to "abide in him" in order that we "bear much fruit." To abide in Jesus is to stay united to him, centered on him in all of life. It is to obey his word and follow his teachings. Jesus desires us to live lives full of joy and love. As we dwell in him and obey him, we find ourselves transformed to experience this new kind of life. But just as grape vines grow best, not on their own, but tended in a vineyard, we Christians don't grow well on our own. The context of the kind of life Jesus desires for us is in a fellowship of believers. All of the "yous" in John 15 are plural; they are "y'alls" as it were. If we are going to grow and produce the fruit Jesus desires, we must be part of the local church.

Jesus called his disciples into a group, a band of followers. He never sent them out alone but always in 2s and 3s. You cannot experience the life Jesus wants for you alone. You need the Church. The local church is Jesus' instrument for nurturing us, pruning us, and making us fruitful. On Friday, March 15th, from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Saturday, March 16th from 8:30am to 1pm, we will be hosting a new member's retreat. Here we will be looking at what it means to live out our discipleship together as a covenanted band of Jesus's followers. If you have not yet committed yourself to the fellowship of believers here at The Village Church please sign up and plan on attending. HOLY WEEK - SAVE THE DATES












Missionaries Al and Annie Olsen

Al and Annie Olsen worked for Wycliffe for thirty-six years. They joined Wycliffe in 1987, initially serving in support roles as guest house managers in southern Spain. Al administratively supported and encouraged fellow Wycliffe members as they transitioned to a different role. Annie designed computer fonts so that people could read the Bible in their preferred language and script. They have worked in southern Mexico, east Africa, Kenya, and Tanzania, and currently reside in Texas.



Bible translation is speeding up as the year 2025 approaches! In 1999 Wycliffe adopted the vision that by the year 2025 every language which still needed translated Scriptures would have one started. Local churches are becoming even more engaged in this process, and incredible progress is being made. Past translation strategies focused primarily on the New Testament, but it is becoming more common to find communities so encouraged by it that there is local support for the team to continue working to translate the Old Testament, too! Please pray for all of the language communities where God's word is still not easily accessible, if at all.

They retired from Wycliffe on November 30th. Following a required two-month sabbatical, they will be returning as volunteers. Annie has always intended to return and continue with font design work. These are specific gifts that the Lord has given her, and she desires to manage them well in retirement.

They still desire to serve the Lord with the talents and abilities He has given them, just a little slower than when they began in 1987. As retired volunteers they are limited to a maximum of 20 hours per week and ineligible to hold leadership positions. With these two points in play, it will help them to focus their time and provide more flexibility in their days.

More translation is happening and more people are involved in creating access to God's Word today than ever before, and they desire to keep helping. If you wish to continue to partner with them financially after November, you do not need to do anything differently, and you will still receive a tax-deductible receipt. You may be wondering, "What's my role in this change?" First, please keep them in your prayers. Doing God's work in God's way still requires that they work in His strength, not their own. Second, if you are willing to continue partnering with them, your gifts will be recorded and sent as 1099 pension. The Mission Committee will continue to support Al and Annie at a reduced level as they enter this new phase.

Al and Annie thank everyone who has partnered with them over these last 36+ years. More translation is happening and more people are involved in creating access to God's Word today than ever before! 
