VILLAGE CHURCH MISSIONS

The Village Church Missions – Supporting the Great Commission

The Village Church is committed to carrying out the “great commission” given by Jesus to His disciples. As Pastor Jeff preached on Resurrection Sunday, Jesus intends that all members of His church be involved in spreading the Good News “to the ends of the earth”.

A number of Village Church people are involved in short-term missions as well as in supporting a variety of Christian mission activities. This year members of The Village Church are serving in the US through Samaritan’s Purse disaster relief and rebuilding, in Romania through YouthCompass, and in Belize through a dental clinic. In addition, some of our youth are participating in a mission trip to the Oakland, CA.

Our congregation, including the Women’s Ministry, supports missions by providing financial support to individual missionaries and mission organizations. The Session allocates at least 10% of all undesignated annual general giving to missions which in 2018 was apportioned as follows: local (30%), national (13%), international (36%), and short-term team support (14%). This leaves 7% undesignated for additional giving to support unforeseen opportunities. *(Please see the mission budget included in The Village Church Annual Report for 2018.)*

The Session is committed to enhancing the awareness of and commitment to missions of our congregation, both adults and youth. Accordingly, the Session has a Missions Committee, and the Women’s Ministry has its own committee for this purpose. We are in the process of setting up a Missions Bulletin Board on the wall leading to the Fireside Room to display information about the individual missionaries and mission organizations we currently support. Each year current recipients are reviewed and others considered for possible support. The Missions Committee is developing criteria to ensure that support decisions are consistent with the beliefs of our local church and denomination.

All members and friends of The Village Church are encouraged to become more involved in supporting missions either through direct participation and/or through donations. Please contact the Missions Committee or Women’s Ministry if you have questions or desire more information on how to become involved.

Finally, please continue to pray for all missionaries and mission organizations working to bring the love, peace, and joy of Christ to our hurting community, nation and world.

Wednesdays at 6:30 a.m.**

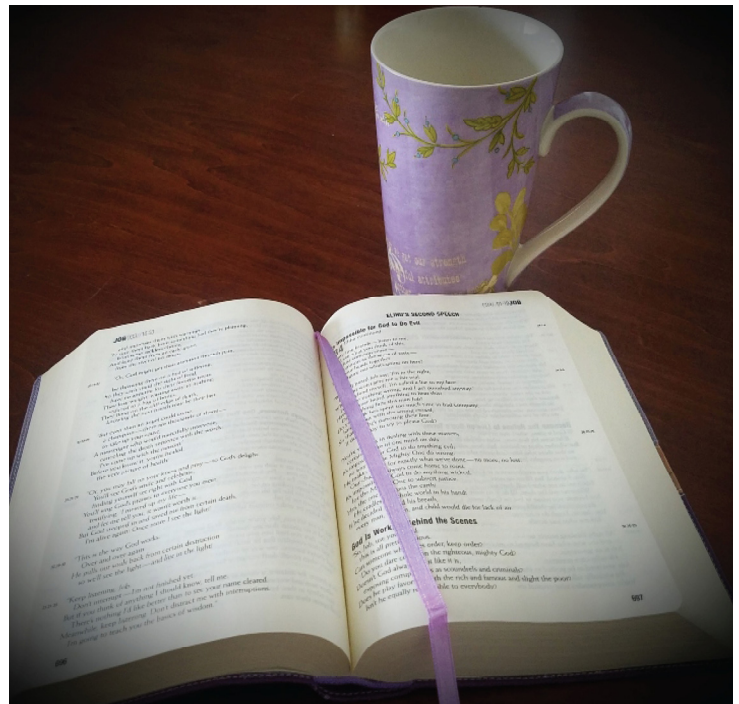

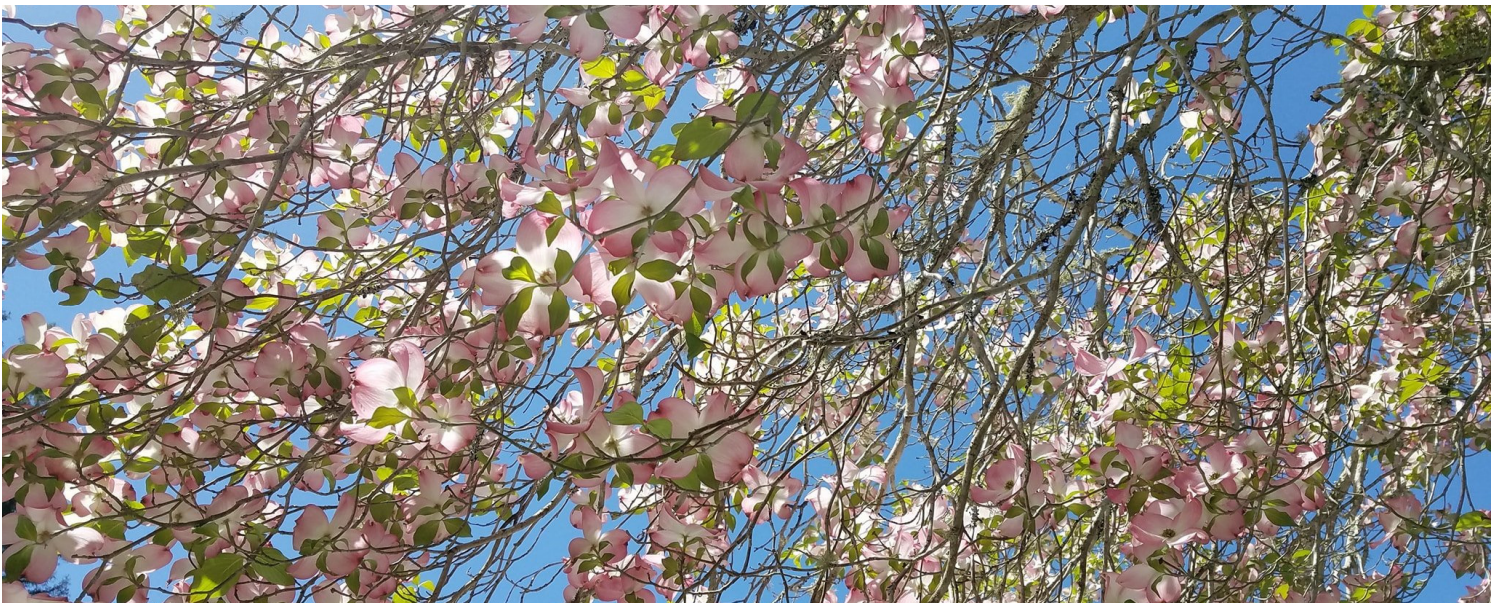
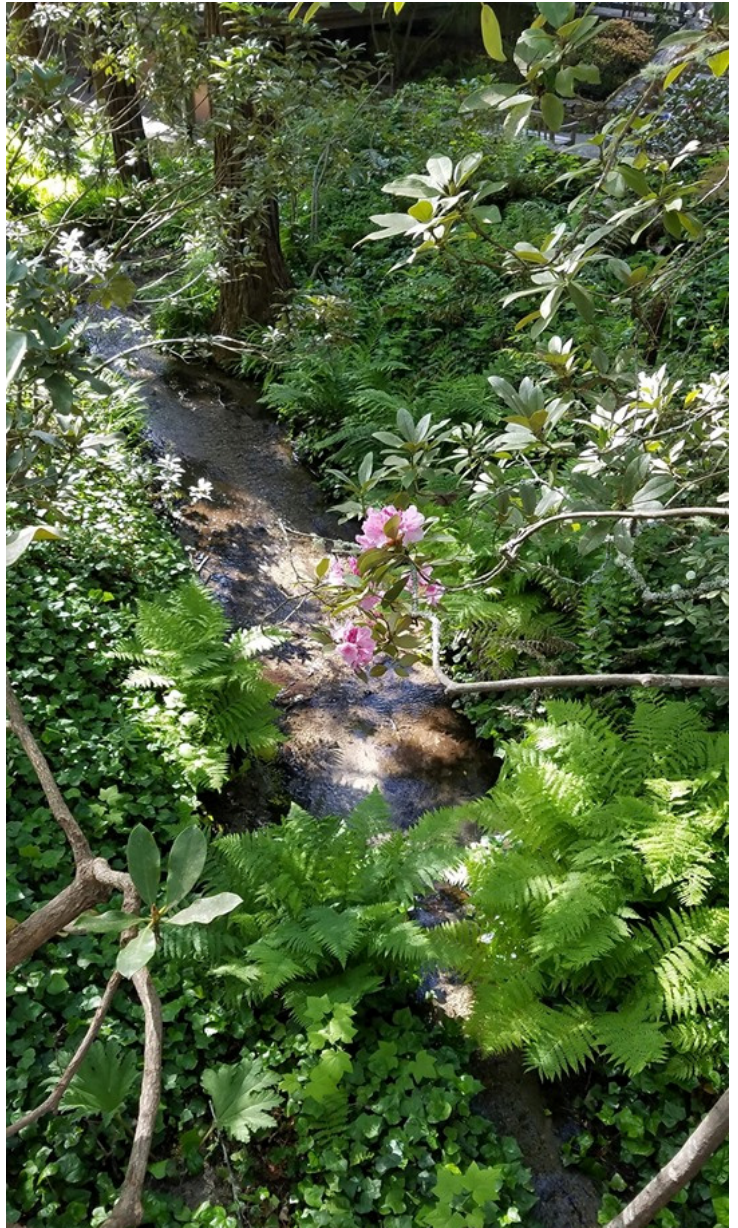

THE VILLAGE CHURCH IS A PRAYING CHURCH!

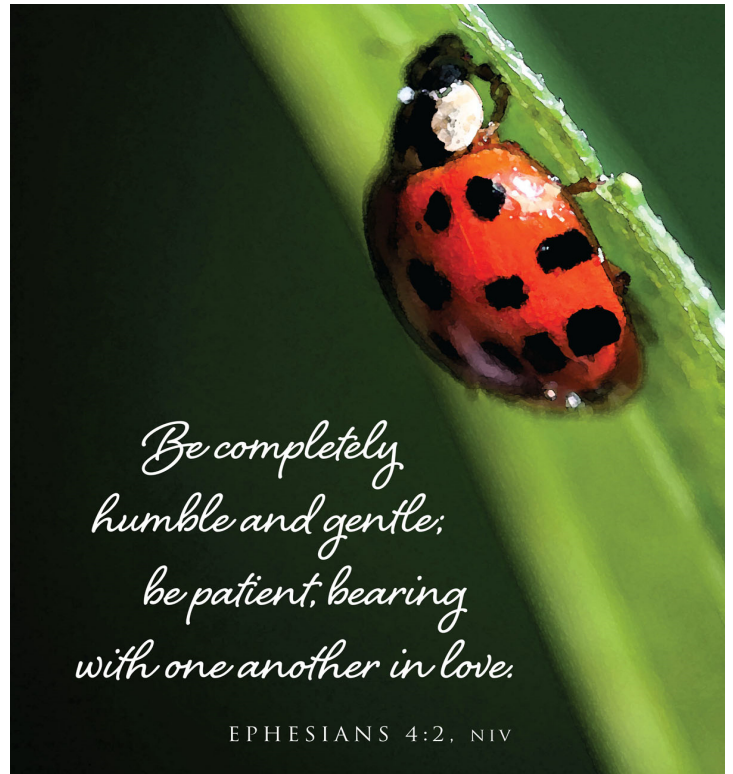
