


From Pastor Jeff

"Blessed is the one who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night." (Psalm 1:1-2)

Have you ever wondered what it is that leads to human flourishing? The Bible gives this answer in many places. One place is found in Psalm 1. Psalm 1 is the gateway Into the Book of Psalms and is placed at the very beginning for a reason. Psalm 1 lays out for us the path of flourishing, the path the Lord's people should walk. The Psalm begins by telling us first which road not to take: "Blessed is the one who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, or stand in the way of sinners, or sit in the seat of mockers," and then lays out the road of the blessed and righteous. The righteous person, Psalm 1 tells us, delights "in the law of the Lord, and on His law he meditates day and night."

The people of God are those committed to walk His road according to His way. The word "law" in this verse is the Hebrew word "Torah," which might be better translated "instruction." The Torah is that body of knowledge given to us by God for a flourishing life. The people of God are those who take delight in God's instruction and who meditate on it day and night. The word "to meditate" here is a Hebrew word which can be translated "mutter" or "growl" and is used of lions growling over their prey (Isaiah 31:4a) The sense is "to recite or read to oneself," in other words, not just to ponder and rehearse in our minds, but aloud! We might say "to chew on" a problem or concept. Like a lion with a bone, God's people are called to delight in and chew on God's word, to appropriate it in their hearts and memories until it instructs all they do. This is the road to a blessed life!

MISSION COMMITTEE REPORT

World Vision

Our Village Church supports World Vision with missionary dollars. Here's why:

As their mission statement says: "Believing that no child is lost. No situation is hopeless. Because our hope is in Jesus."

Founded in 1950 with a small sum in support of one child, World Vision progressed in the 1970's to help stranded Vietnamese refugees with Operation Clean Sweep.

They were first in and last out in serving the victims of the Ethiopian famine in the 1980's. In the 1990's they took a controversial stance in getting the Church to care about the AIDS crisis.

In the 2000's they focused on rebuilding lives after the Asian tsunami crisis. Today they focus on helping more than 3.5 Million at risk children in nearly 100 countries.

Committed to the poor, and especially poor and disadvantaged children, World Vision bears witness to the redemption offered through faith in Jesus Christ.

They seek to follow Him - His identification with the Poor, the afflicted, the oppressed and the marginalized. In terms of efficiency, 88% of each dollar goes to children and families, 5% to overhead, and 7% to fundraising expenses. Their impact is even further magnified by grants and donated goods that have the effect of more than one dollar impact for each dollar donated. They go where others don't. To the hard places where Jesus would go.

PASTORAL CONTACT


