YOUTH NEWS


Happy Thanksgiving Season,



This fall, GNC is focusing on David: having a heart for God, and Daniel: having courage when you are the only Christian among your circle of friends. It is a welcome blessing that Incline Elementary has generously provided GNC with a spare classroom for its use. This classroom provides more space for children to move about and get their wiggles out.



This is a reminder that the church office and the Preschool will be closed November 22^{nd} and 23^{rd} to celebrate Thanksgiving.








