From Pastor Jeff

A few years ago I read a book by English clergyman and scholar, N.T. Wright. It's called <u>The Resurrection of the Son of God</u>. It's a big book, over 740 pages of smallish type and it took me a while to work my way through it in fits and starts. It is a masterful and exhaustive volume examining the whole concept of resurrection held by the different cultures in Jesus' day. It's a fantastic book and filled with great insights, but I was really struck by one little section towards the end.



Wright points out that all of the references to Jesus' resurrection in the later New Testament focus on it's implication for our own futures: "Jesus is risen, therefore you will be too." In the Gospels themselves though, there is an entirely different focus: "Jesus is risen, therefore you have work ahead of you." This emphasis is found in all four of the Gospels. The Easter proclamation is "Jesus is risen, now go and tell somebody." The women at the tomb are commanded to go tell the disciples, the disciples to tell the whole earth. The sermons of the Apostles recorded in Acts show that telling everyone about the resurrection was exactly what they did.

I think it's important for us to keep both of these ideas about the resurrection in our hearts. It's of personal comfort for each of us who believe in Jesus to know that he will raise us from the dead, never to die again, just as he has been raised and now lives for ever and ever. It is just as important though, that like the first disciples, we share our knowledge of the Risen Lord with others. We who've begun to experience eternal life must tell others. Jesus is risen and we've got work ahead of us. Jesus is risen! Now go tell somebody!







Samaritan's Purse

HELPING IN JESUS' NAME. That is the mission of Samaritan's purse. Christians can be assured that their gifts to Samaritan's Purse are monies well spent, and that the missions of the organization are always bathed in prayer from start to finish and everywhere in between. Samaritan's Purse, founded by Franklin Graham, son of evangelist Billy Graham, serves in several areas to help those in need. Among these are Operation Christmas Child, Heal our Patriots, Disaster Relief, and the Children's Heart Project. To read about those projects, as well as other worldwide efforts, go to samaritanspurse.org. Once on the website not only is it easy to learn about the missions of Samaritan's Purse, but it is also easy to give in support of an area that touches your heart. Currently Samaritan's Purse is operating an Emergency Field Hospital in Lviv, Ukraine. Below is information on that ongoing effort.

Samaritan's Purse Receives First Patients at Emergency Field Hospital in Ukraine Boone, N.C., March 14, 2022—Today, international Christian relief organization Samaritan's Purse accepted its first patients at the **Emergency Field Hospital** located on the outskirts of Lviv. The 58-bed unit was airlifted to Poland last week, then transported across the border to Ukraine. The Emergency Field Hospital is equipped to meet critical trauma needs of patients impacted by the conflict. It contains an emergency room, Intensive Care Unit (ICU), and two operating theaters—providing Samaritan's Purse medical staff with the capacity to perform up to 30 surgeries per day.

"God calls us to go into crisis areas to help those who are most vulnerable," said **Franklin Graham**, president of Samaritan's Purse. "As the conflict escalates in Ukraine, our international disaster response teams with doctors, nurses, and other specialists are equipped and ready to help people in Jesus' Name. We want them to know that God loves them and has not forgotten them."

Samaritan's Purse is also working in Moldova and Poland to meet emergency needs as Ukrainian refugees cross the border. Disaster response specialists are distributing food, drinking water, hygiene kits, and other critical supplies.



Pictured at left is Marina from Malyn, a city west of Kyiv. She was the first patient at the Emergency Field Hospital in the Ukraine. She had injured her arm while escaping into a bomb shelter and suffered for nine days before arriving at our field hospital. She cried tears of relief when we told her we could help her.




