


From Pastor Jeff

"Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God... For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy."

#### Exodus 20:8-11

For almost 3500 years, it has been the practice of the Jewish people to worship God on the Sabbath, the seventh day of the week (our Saturday). God instituted this ordinance in the 4<sup>th</sup> Commandment given to Moses at Mt. Sinai. We Christians though worship on Sunday, the first day of the week. Why? If Jesus, Peter, Paul and all of the early church were Jewish, why did the early church begin to meet and worship on the first day of the week (See Acts 20:7 and 1 Corinthians 16:2)? What caused them to change their practice? The answer is found in the resurrection of Jesus. All four Gospels make clear that Jesus rose from the dead on the first day of the week (See Matt. 28:1, Mk. 16:2, Mk. 16:9, Lk. 24:1, Jn. 20:1, Jn. 20:19). The Apostles came to realize that just as the Sabbath day commandment celebrated the rest of God at the first Creation, so the Lord's Day looked forward to the rest waiting the people of God in the New Creation (See



Hebrews 4:9-10). Jesus' resurrection was the first act of the new creation, a foretaste of what will come for all believers at his return.

The early church began to meet and share the Lord's Supper on the Lord's Day to celebrate Jesus' resurrection and look forward to his return. The Sunday of Jesus' resurrection is, so to speak, the "Mother of All Sundays," but for us every Sunday is to be a celebration of Jesus' resurrection. When we meet on Sundays, it's to remind ourselves again and again that evil has been conquered, death has been undone and that forgiveness and mercy have won; that life has the final word. So come to worship this Sunday and celebrate Jesus Victory on the Lord's Day.





#### VILLAGE CHURCH MISSIONS

This month the Mission Committee would like to spotlight **Kids Alive International** – an organization that is being supported for their work to rescue, redeem and restore children who are victims of sexual crimes in Guatemala. Kids Alive International believes that every child, even those with the most challenging needs, is a



priority to God, and far too many are overlooked, unheard exploited, and threatened.

In Guatemala there is a sexual crime committed against children every two hours. Kids Alive – Guatemala responds to this need by working with government institutions, non-government organizations and local churches to build a ministry of redemption, restoration and justice. They serve as a training organization for other ministries and the government – training them

to be better equipped to care for children with trauma and working with families for reconciliation. They are committed to see each child as a unique creation of God with the right to a family, education, health, recreation and justice. Their multidisciplinary ministry includes: Oasis and Arquilla Residential Programs, Families Together Program and the Casa Ester Transition to Independent Living Program. In addition, there is a Comprehensive Care Center in Escuintla and the newest addition, Fuente de Esperanza (Source of Hope) School, located in the remote El Zapote community. During 2021, their facilities served 366 children.



Girls placed in residential care arrive by an order of protection and temporary shelter given by a judge. The Escuintla Care Center provides Christian counseling, professional care, and access to other resources for families as they seek to forge a new life of hope. The Casa Ester Transition Program was developed when the organization realized that many girls who grew up in a residential program did not have a safe family to

live with when they turned 18. In this supportive environment they are enrolled in school, learn skills that will benefit them

personally and vocationally and continue in discipleship programs. Kids Alive – Guatemala recognizes that it is within

a family unit (where children feel loved and protected), and not an institutional environment, that children will achieve their maximum development and a healthy identity. To that end, The Families Together Program seeks the reintegration and reunification of the child with her nuclear family, extended family, or placement with a foster family. During 2021, thirty-seven girls were able to go to family care: 12 to their biological family, 18 to other types of family care, and 7 to a foster family.

As you can imagine, providing all these services is a huge undertaking. The Mission Committee is grateful to be able to support this essential ministry. You can find much more information on the Kids Alive programs in Guatemala on their <u>website</u>.


