# **Not A Tame God**

One of my favorite series of books is the Chronicles of Narnia by C. S. Lewis. These books are Faerie Tales full of talking animals and mythical creatures and all kinds of adventures. They are also full of symbols and allegories that describe aspects of the Christian faith. In these books the figure of Jesus is represented by the Lion, Aslan, who comes and goes at will, who saves and judges, who is compassionate and wild. "Not like a tame lion" is how Aslan is described. Lewis was onto something in his portrait of Jesus. Since the beginning of time we humans have been on a quest to tame God. We want a God we can control and a God we can understand. We want a God who will give us whatever we want; a God who will confirm all our projects and prejudices, who will underwrite our patriotism and politics. As comfortable and pleasing as this domesticated deity may be, it is a false deity.

There is only one true God, and he has revealed himself to us in the person of the Lord Jesus Christ, and Jesus will not be tamed. He will not conform to our programs or desires. He is Himself. We find this over and over in the Gospels. People come to Jesus, expecting him to conform to their program, and find that they must join his or be irrelevant. Following Jesus is the requirement for eternal life. He makes this statement repeatedly: "Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for *my sake* will



find it." Matthew 10:39; "Everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or fields for *my sake* will receive a hundred times as much and will inherit eternal life." Matthew 19:29; "Follow *me*, and let the dead bury their own dead" Matthew 8:22.

In the Gospels, Jesus redefines all of life to be about absolute loyalty to himself. All areas of life or death belong to him. A person must either acknowledge his Lordship and swear fealty to him, or remain outcast in the far country, alone and abandoned until ultimate night falls. He cannot be tamed or made safe. We must conform to his image, not he to ours. He is "the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. [The one] who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve his God and Father - to him be glory and power for ever and

ever! Amen." Revelations 1:5-6.

# Missions Spotlight on NetWorks Romania

In 2012, Tim Gilbert volunteered with Youth Compass to serve on Project Compassion in Romania. In Taut, he met Lee Seville, who is the president and founder of NetWorks Romania. Lee has lived in Romania since 1996 and co-founded a charity working with street children. It successfully opened a day center for street children, a school program, and six homes for children and young people formerly living on the streets. Lee also managed the charity's trading company, which provided training and employment for young people. In 2001, Lee recognized the need to address the complex social and economic issues that lead



to children and young people living on the streets, and he co-founded NetWorks. The Village Church Missions committee has recently decided to support NetWorks.

NetWorks is an inter-denominational, Holy Spirit led, Christian mission working among some of the poorest people in northwest Romania to achieve their physical and spiritual transformation. NetWorks is in the county of Arad near the border with Hungary. It operates mainly in and around three communities: in the city of Arad, in the village of Şiria and in the villages surrounding Taut.

NetWorks is an inter-denominational missions team with missionaries currently from Romania, England, Wales, Ireland, Sweden, Holland and the U.S.A. Over the years, its team has been made up of people from Baptist, Pentecostal, Charismatic, Presbyterian, Anglican, Lutheran, Free Methodist, and Greek Orthodox backgrounds. The missions team is supported by both full time and part-time Romanian staff as well as short and medium-term volunteers from around the world.

In 1996, members of the NetWorks team began working with street children, and it was these children that became their teachers, leading them into communities of extreme poverty to meet their families and helping to understand the scale of the challenges that families faced daily. As friendships were built, the model that has developed into what is now called **E3** was born.

**E3**: Education Empowerment Employment The E3 model was developed over a period of more than 20 years in response to a common need.

It has become increasingly clear that *education* is one of the fundamental keys to breaking the cycles that trap entire families in extreme poverty for generations. Education is not only about learning to read and write, but it is also about changing the way we think about ourselves and the world around us. *Empowering* a family to better understand and access their legal rights and to be able to utilize the resources that they have available to them (for example by lending basic tools and equipment) are some of the




ways in which to help them be able to better provide for themselves. *Employment* is empowering and brings hope and creates opportunities. Many of the poor are strong and able to work, but no-one in their family has

ever had a job. Networks helps people to begin their own small business, and run its microenterprises to help create work within a community.




