

What is Lent?



This year the season of Lent began on Wednesday, February 22nd. Lent is a period of 40 days (not including Sundays) before Easter and has been celebrated by the Church since antiquity. What is Lent for? Why have Christians observed these days through the centuries? As this statement adapted from the Book of Common Prayer states, it is an ancient season of preparation, self-examination, and prayer:

The first Christians observed with great devotion the days of our Lord's passion and resurrection, and it became the custom of the Church to prepare for them by a season of penitence and fasting. This season of Lent provided a time in which converts to the faith were prepared for Holy Baptism. It was also a time when those who, because of notorious sins, had been separated from the bod of the faithful were reconciled by penitence and forgiveness, and restored to the fellowship of the Church. Thereby, the whole congregation was put in mind of the message of pardon and absolution set forth in the Gospel of our Savior, and of the need which all Christians continually have to renew their repentance and faith.

So Lent is a season to check the state of our discipleship. How are we doing at following Jesus? Has anything crept in between us and our Lord? That's what "giving something up for Lent"

is actually about: getting rid of anything that pulls us away from the Lord. It's a season to add in practices that draw us closer to the Lord. We have Lenten devotionals at the church that can be useful for developing a habit of quiet time with the Lord. I close with the words of the Book of Common Prayer:

You are invited, therefore, to the observance of a holy Lent, by self-examination and repentance; by prayer, fasting, and self-denial; and by reading and meditating on God's holy Word.

May God Bless us during this Lent season!

Lent is the forty day period Lenten between Ash Wednesday and Easter, not including Sundays, of penitence and preparation for Christ's


HOLY WEEK - SAVE THE DATES

EASTER SUNDAY 4/9 -Pastor Jeff will lead a Sunrise Service at 7:15am at Burnt Cedar Beach.






WHY WE SING IN WORSHIP

Quite often there is a tension in churches between those who like the old hymns and those who prefer the new worship music - referred to as the "worship wars." We are blessed in this body to have two different ways to praise Him through music. The songs sung during our 8:00 a.m. service are old hymns of the faith. The 10:00 a.m. service offers us the opportunity and blessing to sing with our excellent praise band though newer songs of our faith. This has been a successful structure for our worship community.

Here at The Village Church, we take prayerful care in selecting the music shared during worship. Although singing is not worship itself, it is a way we speak to our living God. We try to be mindful that, as a praise team, we are there to lead, encourage and enable folks to praise through music. It is not a performance - it is a tangible exaltation and exclamation of God's awesome glory and power.

When choosing new songs for the praise team to share, we are careful that the message and lyrics are Biblically sound and we try to rearrange most songs to minimize unnecessary repetition. Prayerfully working with Pastor Jeff, we try to reflect



and support his sermon and scripture readings through the song selection. It's not always a bull-seye!

Singing to our God has been around since the earliest gatherings of people to worship. Singing is a vital part of how we do church together, shoulder to shoulder and soul to soul. We are blessed to be able to serve this body of believers through music, standing beside you. We hope and pray that you, in turn, are blessed through lifting your voices to our Lord and Savoir. Keep singing to Him...with all your heart, soul and being.

Anchor Point Lodge

Mountain Metro Church, established in 2014, is the heart and vision of Kirsten Vliet Cirne with the Beloved in Christ Foundation. Her goal was to help facilitate a church and retreat center which would have an impact for the kingdom of God in and around the Tahoe basin where people travel to and from around the country and across the world. The hope and prayer was that a multitude of different people from diverse backgrounds would have the opportunity to experience God's amazing beauty in Lake Tahoe. In November of 2019, the Beloved in Christ Foundation provided the funds for Mountain Metro Church to purchase the old Episcopal Church and middle school Outdoor Adventure Retreat Center, now renamed Anchor Point Lodge.
