# From Pastor Jeff

There came a point in the history of Israel when they felt that they had been abandoned by the Lord. They had been sent into exile. All their prayers seemed unanswered, Jerusalem remained desolate and the Temple, a ruin—their hopes dashed, their future bleak. Isaiah recorded this moment in the middle of chapter 49 of his book. Isaiah 49:14 reads, "But Zion said, 'the LORD has forsaken me, the Lord has forgotten me." Notice the small capital letters of that first Lord. That is the way most English translation signify that the name used in the original Hebrew text is YHWH, the Covenant name of God. So, here Israel is saying, "YHWH, the covenant-keeping God, has forsaken his covenant people." What terrible anguish must have led them to the place of making such an accusation! Can the covenant-keeping, almighty, all-knowing God forget his covenant people? God forbid!

Listen to the Lord's reply in Isaiah 49:15-16, "Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion for the child she is born? Though she may forget, I will not forget you! See, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands; your walls are ever before me."

God says to his people in their doubt and distress, "I love you more than a mother loves her nursing baby. I can never forget you!" God uses the graphic image of carving the remembrance of his people on the palms of his hands to reinforce how close and dear his people are to him. Clearly behind this image are the nail-scarred hands of Jesus. God loves his frail, feeble, wayward people so much that, far from forgetting them in their exile and distress, he himself has atoned for their sins and, for eternity, wears the scars of their redemption in his flesh. No matter how we feel in our present pain and sorrows, remember that God has not forgotten you and his love is forever!

Back in 1707, Isaac Watts paraphrased these verses from Isaiah in the last 3 stanzas of a poem, titled "Now Shall My Inward Joys Arise." The whole poem is worth reading but I will leave you with these:

Can a kind woman e'er forget The infant of her womb, And 'mongst a thousand tender thoughts Her suckling have no room?

"Yet," saith the Lord, "should nature change, And mothers monsters prove, Zion still dwells upon the heart Of everlasting love."

"Deep on the palms of both my hands I have engrav'd her name; My hands shall raise her ruin'd walls, And build her broken frame."

# Dear friend,

Since 1993, Samaritan's Purse has collected more than 168 million shoeboxes packed with toys and other fun items by people like you, and delivered them to boys and girls in need around the world in partnership with local churches.

Sampil who has cerebral palsy received one of those shoebox gifts. Volunteers in his hometown of Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, hosted an Operation Christmas Child outreach event for disabled children like him, but he was sick that day. Not wanting him to miss out, a volunteer visited Sampil's house to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with him and give him a gift-filled shoebox. Sampil was delighted to find, among other fun items, a towel, toothbrush, and various school supplies inside.

"After I got a shoebox, I became a Christian and my relationships with others changed," Sampil said. He hadn't been to school in years, but the notebooks in his gift inspired him to enroll in a school for the disabled where he made many friends. Aware of Christ's forgiveness of his sins, Sampil also forgave his father who left his family more than 10 years ago. Today, Sampil has since graduated and serves as an assistant teacher at a camp.

Many boys and girls who receive shoebox gifts also enroll in The Greatest Journey, our 12-lesson follow-up discipleship program, where they learn to follow Christ and share Him with others. Millions of boys and girls have participated in this dynamic course so far.

# CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Good News Club® is a ministry of Child Evangelism Fellowship in which trained teachers meet with groups of children just about anywhere the children can easily and safely meet with their parent's permission. Each week

the teacher presents an exciting Bible lesson using colorful materials from CEF Press. This action-packed time also includes songs, Scripture memory, a missions story and review games or other activities focused on the lesson's theme. The purpose of *Good News Club* is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and disciple them in the Word of God. Each club includes a clear presentation of the Gospel and an opportunity for children to trust the Lord Jesus as Savior. Every club also includes strong discipleship training to build character and strengthen moral and spiritual growth. All children are encouraged to attend a local church.

Darlene Nilsson, and her GNC crew meet weekly on Thursday at Incline Elementary School from 3:15 – 5:00 PM in room 218. This fall, GNC is focusing on David: having a heart for God, and Daniel: having courage when you are the only Christian among your circle of friends. The lessons are tailored to meet the needs of the group and include many means of engaging the children through movement, games, silliness, giggles, and fun.

The 2019-20 calendar year for Good News Club started in October, and God has already brought many blessings to this ministry. The Lord has blessed GNC with children! There are seventeen children currently attending regularly, and we expect more to join the group as the school year progresses. One child has already made professions of faith and accepted Christ as her savior.

It is a welcome blessing that Incline Elementary has generously provided GNC with a spare classroom for its use. This classroom provides more space for children to move about and get their wiggles out.

Statistics show that the great majority of people who accept Christ do so between the ages of four and fourteen – when they are children. There are several opportunities to be involved with *Good News Club*. 
A big big thank you to all the volunteers that helped out at these events and to all of the people who donated candy!

This is a reminder that the Church Office and the Preschool will be closed November 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> to celebrate Thanksgiving.




