



Jobs for Life

Jobs for Life's mission is to create pathways to meaningful work and entrepreneurial opportunities through community engagement. Jobs for Life (JfL) engages and equips local churches and non-profits to address the impact of joblessness through the dignity of work. Work isn't simply about what we do, it is also about who we are and created to be. Established in Raleigh, NC, in 1996, JfL addresses the root causes of unemployment, underemployment, and disengagement with work by uniting churches, businesses, and community organizations and by facilitating positive transformation within lives and communities.

Jobs for Life was started when Pastor Donald McCoy, pastor of Pleasant Hill United Church of Christ contacted Chris Mangum's business about paving the church parking lot. The church paving project went so well that Chris and Pastor McCoy became close friends, deciding to meet for lunch on a regular basis. During one of those lunches, Chris shared with Pastor McCoy that several of CC Mangum's trucks were sitting parked due to lack of drivers. Pastor McCoy responded that he had able-bodied men and women in the church and neighborhood who were parked just like Chris' trucks due to a lack of jobs. They realized they each had something the other needed. Chris had jobs, Pastor McCoy had people. They found other pastors and businesspeople who had the same needs, and through their collective efforts, Jobs for Life was born. What was started in a moment during lunch is now a network of churches, ministries, and businesses in cities all over the world training men and women for work and transforming people's lives.

Why Work?

Work brings dignity to people all over the world. Knowing and embracing God's purpose for work offers a long-term solution to issues that plague the heart and the community.

We're Created to Work

Through work, we understand our true identity. The primary issue with the unemployed is dealing with the loss of identity. We were created in the image of God, with value and worth, fearfully and wonderfully made, with gifts, talents, and purpose.

Work Is Good and Makes God's World Work

Through work, we participate as co-creators with God. We use our gifts to care for His creation and allow it to flourish. No job is better than another. There is just as much dignity in the work of a janitor as a doctor, and it all makes the world go round and is good in God's eyes.

Work Brings Glory to God

We work for God and not for men. Every task, assignment or meeting is an opportunity to shine a light on God and His goodness. In all of what we do, God is using our work as a declaration of his glory and power.

When People Don't Work

A lack of work contributes to poverty, crime, homelessness, domestic violence, substance abuse, unwanted pregnancies, divorce, and suicide. NOTHING ATTACKS ONE'S DIGNITY LIKE LACK OF WORK. The suffering and consequences of unemployment and underemployment are pervasive and heart-wrenching; it is self-perpetuating and tears at the fabric of society.


