This has been another exciting year at The Village Church. Our understanding of God's Word is currently being deepened as we collectively study the fundamental doctrines of our faith. This fall, we will continue to grow in our faith and practices as we study the doctrines of salvation and service in the Christian life.

Service at The Village Church is manifested in numerous ways. We serve with our time, talents, and treasures. Although committing support through financial resources may be a touchy

subject, Christ showed no reservation. Numerous verses state unequivocally that God owns it all and we need to hold our possessions with an open hand. Other verses tell us that we are stewards of what God has entrusted to us. An owner (God) has rights but a steward (us) has responsibilities. Society says, "I possess, I own, and I'm in control." The Bible says, "God owns, God's in control" and we are only stewards of what he has entrusted us, the 100%, not just the 10%.

There are several ways to financially contribute to our church. These include setting up auto-pay with your bank, making gifts of appreciated assets, naming the church as a beneficiary in your will or trust, donating your IRA required minimum distribution, and creating Charitable Remainder Trusts.

In recent years we have seen an increase in giving from Donor Advised Fund (DAF). This is partly due to the recent change in tax law that doubled the standard deduction minimizing the tax benefit of charitable contribution for some people. The DAF can restore charitable deduction benefits while also using the standard deduction. The DAF can also benefit those with uneven or deferred income, sale of stock or property, and opportunity to establish legacy giving with your children and grandchildren. Setting up a DAF is easy not requiring services of an attorney or trust tax reporting. A discussion of these benefits will be presented at church on October 13th at noon in the Fireside Room.

Enclosed you will find a pledge form. As faithful stewards, we hope you will prayerfully consider increasing your financial and time commitment to The Village Church for 2020 to help maintain and expand our service in our church, community, and the world at large.

Thank you for your support of our Lord's ministry through The Village Church and for living your faith through your commitment.

WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY October 6th


The Lord's Supper this month is also part of World Communion Sunday. It will be celebrated at both our Sunday

VILLAGE CHURCH MISSIONS

Missionaries Al and Annie Olsen

Al and Annie Olsen have worked for Wycliffe for thirty-two years. The mission of Wycliffe is to see a Bible translation program in progress in every language still needing one by 2025. Their vision is to see God's Word made accessible to all people in the language of their hearts.

Al and Annie joined Wycliffe in 1987, initially serving in support roles as guest house managers in southern Spain. Since then, Al has served in a variety of administrative roles, from computer support to management training, operations and logistics, and member care. In 2003, God led Annie to her niche in type design for non-Roman and complex scripts (think computer fonts), and she has served there ever since. They have also worked in southern Mexico, east Africa, Kenya, and Tanzania. While currently residing in Texas, Al is Resource Coordinator for Wycliffe Bible Translators, and Annie is Type Designer for SIL International.

Al also joined The Village Church on their first mission trip with Samaritan's Purse in Texas. He worked alongside our team leader, Daniel, building counters and laying tile for the kitchen in a small house in Gregory occupied by an extended family of six.


Bible translation requires teamwork on multiple levels. Annie and Al still need people to partner with them in prayer and finances so that they can continue serving in their support roles. Annie's Writing Systems Technology team has font engineers, font designers, script researchers and administrators collaborating to produce fonts, keyboards, and related tools useful for translation. Actual translation work takes national translators, their local community to read and hear it, consultants, typesetters, and many others to share their knowledge, skills, and experience.

The following is an example of great translation teamwork: Paulo Kijuu, a translator working in his own Rangi (Tanzania) language, had heard John 15:5 many times, in Swahili and in English. When his team was working on that passage with their translation consultant, they talked about *abiding in Jesus* and what that means. The expression is not clear to Rangi speakers. Recognizing the team's struggle, the consultant asked questions to guide their search for a better expression. Finally, they found a figure of speech which the Rangi used to describe two very good friends, or a couple who love one another very much. The expression in Rangi, *kuva kiintu kimwi*, literally means *to be one thing*. "When we put this expression in our translation," recalls Kijuu, "my eyes became teary, because I was able to visualize my relationship with Jesus. When I live in him, I am one thing with him. I saw how Jesus takes care of me. I could feel his love, and I could see a whole new life with him."




