#### VILLAGE CHURCH MISSIONS

The Village Church has been supporting *Reno Adolescent Boy's Teen Challenge* since 2017. The ministry is part of *Adult & Teen Challenge*, an international organization with over 200 residential treatment programs in the United States and over 1000 around the

world. They have been guiding students through addiction recovery for over 60 years. The program offers a Christ-centered approach, helping students discover and triumph over the underlying causes of their addiction and find the love and grace of Jesus Christ.

In 1958, David Wilkerson, the founder of the organization, made a great step of faith from his rural Pennsylvania pulpit to the streets of New York City, where a murder trial of seven teenage boys churned society's antipathy toward them. Even Wilkerson was bewildered by his sense of compassion but, in spite of doubt, he followed the Spirit's prompting to help the boys. Wilkerson's outreach to gangs in New York led to the development of Teen Challenge, and his street ministry is the subject of the book (and movie) *The Cross and the Switchblade*, which he co-authored.

The belief that addiction destroys more than the body, has led *Adult and Teen Challenge* to develop programs that consider all aspects of their students' lives. Understanding that addiction starts as a way to fulfill a void that only God can fill, has made a strong relationship with the Lord a foundational tenet to the program. This foundation is built in the students by teaching them the Word of God and by encouraging them to bond with other growing disciples. One example of this is that as supporters of the program, The Village Church receives handwritten notes from teen boys in the local program, sharing their personal stories.


Locations offer a variety of services (for example, the Reno/Sparks location we support works with adolescent boys) that provide help for people struggling with drugs, alcohol, and other life controlling issues. There are also programs for adults, couples, and families. Admission requirements, fees, and tuition costs vary from program to program.

The programs usually last 12-18 months. This gives the students the time they need to reconnect with God and form a strong connection. The combination of Christian values and a long recovery period makes all the difference - another big reason that the students avoid relapse.

Our Reno-Sparks facility is a part of the NorWestCal Nevada branch of the *Adult and Teen Challenge* ministry. The NorWestCal Nevada mission statement is:

... to **provide successful recovery** for men, women, teens, children, and families with destructive, abusive, and addictive lifestyles through mentoring, education, training, and spiritual direction.


#### PASTORAL CONTACT
