





Baptism at The Village Church

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always to the end of the age." Matthew 28:19-21

The Meaning of Baptism

Baptism is the sign and seal of incorporation into Christ. In Baptism, we participate in Jesus' death and resurrection. In Baptism, we are called to die to sin and to a new life in Christ. Baptism points us to the grace of God expressed in Jesus, who died and was raised for us. Baptism points us forward to that same Christ who will come again to make all things new.

In Baptism, the Holy Spirit binds the Church in covenant to its Creator and Lord. The water of Baptism symbolizes the waters of Creation, the Flood, and the Exodus from Egypt. Thus, the water of Baptism links us to the goodness of God's creation and to the grace of God's covenants with Noah and Israel.

The Prophets of Israel, amidst the failure of their own generation to honor God's covenant,



called for justice to roll down like water and righteousness like an everflowing stream. They envisioned a fresh expression of God's grace and of creation's goodness – a new covenant accompanied by the sprinkling of cleansing water. In his ministry, Jesus offered the gift of living water. So, Baptism is the sign and seal of God's grace and covenant in Christ.

As circumcision was the sign and symbol of inclusion in God's grace and covenant with Israel, so Baptism is the sign and symbol of inclusion in God's grace and covenant with the Church. As an identifying mark, Baptism signifies:

- The faithfulness of God,
- The washing away of sin,
- Rebirth,
- Putting on the fresh garment of Christ,
- Being sealed by God's Spirit,
- Adoption into the Church's family,
- Resurrection & illumination in Christ.

Baptism enacts and seals what the Word proclaims: God's redeeming grace offered to all who believe. Baptism is God's gift of grace and also God's summons to respond to that grace. Baptism calls to repentance, to faithfulness, and to discipleship. Baptism gives the follower of Jesus his or her identity and commissions the church for ministry to the world.

Baptism signifies the beginning of life in Christ, not its completion. God's grace works steadily, calling to repentance and newness of life. God's faithfulness needs no renewal. Human faithfulness to God needs repeated renewal. Baptism calls for decision at every subsequent stage of life's way, both for those whose Baptism attends their profession of faith and for those who are nurtured from childhood within the family of faith.

Who Is Baptized

Both believers and their children are included in God's covenant love. Children of believers are to be baptized without undue delay, but without undue haste. Baptism, whether administered to those who profess their faith or to those presented for Baptism as children, is one and the same Sacrament.

Baptism of Children: The Baptism of children witnesses to the truth that God's love claims people before they are able to respond in faith.

Baptism of Adults: The Baptism of those who enter the covenant upon their own profession of faith witnesses to the truth that God's gift of grace calls for fulfillment in a response of faithfulness.

Baptism is received only once. There are many times in worship, however, when believers acknowledge the grace of God continually at work. As they participate in the celebration of another's Baptism, as they experience the sustaining nurture of the Lord's Supper, and as they reaffirm the commitments made at Baptism, they confess their ongoing need of God's grace and pledge anew their obedience to God's Messiah, Jesus.

Do I need to be a church member for my child to be baptized at The Village Church? When a child is being presented for Baptism, ordinarily the parent(s) or one(s) rightly exercising parental responsibility shall be an active member of the congregation. Those presenting children for Baptism shall promise to provide nurture and guidance *within the church* until the child is ready to make a personal profession of faith and assume the responsibility of active church membership. The Session must approve requests to baptize children of parents who are not members of The Village Church.



Sower's Field Ministries Founded and led by Dr. Stanley Wood

Our church through the missions committee has been supporting Sower's Field for many years because it is a very effective and successful church planting ministry.

Sower's Field exists to fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus Christ "to make disciples" through **identifying**, **equipping**, and **empowering** a new generation of leaders who plant new churches; and to help established churches become evangelizing communities of faith where believers are dynamic sharers of the Gospel.

Sower's Field Online provides learning options for laity, bi-vocational and full-time church leadership and for church leadership teams. Teaching options are offered in "short versions" through webinars, workshops, and seminars and in "longer versions" through courses that may be taken for undergraduate and graduate school/seminary credits.

THE NEED

- In the last two decades there are more than 56 million more people in the US who attend no church
- As this church attendance trend continues this means that only one or two people out of every ten people are attending a Christian church as of 2020
- Vibrant church plants focus on people who have not received the saving grace of the Christ—the unchurched
- Just to maintain the presence of the Christian Church in the US at our present percent of the US population, we need to plant more than 24,000 new churches every decade
- The largest unchurched populations in the North American mission field are the iGen and Millennials (late teens, 20s into early 30s)

THE SOWER'S FIELD RESPONSE

The response is found in our Lord's Great Commission "to make disciples"

- The key to church planting is developing leadership
- The Sower's Field response seeks to fulfill the Great Commission by focusing on new leaders for new churches
- There exists today a church planter leadership development vacuum in theological education. Sower's Field provides such education.

Sower's Field equips established churches in recalibrating focus on God's mission—on becoming evangelizing communities of faith.




