

From Pastor Jeff

This month marks my three year anniversary as pastor here at The Village Church. A lot has gone on in that time, in my own life, as a husband, and father, and in the life of the Church. When you look at the changes in the larger world, it's remarkable. Since September of 2014, same-sex marriage and recreational marijuana use have been legalized, a new President has been elected, violence on the far left and right has become commonplace—our culture is changing faster every month it seems. All the old ways and old sureties seem to be called into question.

As I have thought about these changes and the increasing darkness and hostility in our culture, I have looked again at what I believe and what I think Jesus calls His Church to stand for. And I find that, as fast as the culture changes, rushing to embrace each new wave of so-called "progress," my calling and that of the Church remains unchanged. I am called to proclaim Jesus Christ as Messiah and Lord, the Son of the Living God, ruler of Heaven and Earth, Judge of the Living and the Dead. The Church is called to be a refuge for the lost, a hospital for sinners, an outpost of the Kingdom of God, where the Good News of the Kingdom is proclaimed and lived, where the love of God is offered to all who repent and believe.

Love God, love Jesus, love our neighbors, preach the Good News, teach the Truth; it's not rocket science—it is our calling.

chicken and ice cream! Join us for good food and fellowship.




THE SACRAMENT OF THE LORD'S SUPPER September 3rd

While students and parents are busy with beginning of the school year activities, the new Sunday School year curriculum is well underway. The new curriculum year began June 4th and will fluctuate between lessons from the New and Old Testament and Spiritual Life.

The elementary program is taught by dedicated and seasoned teacher volunteers to students in grades 1–5. The lessons began with the miracles Jesus performed while on Earth, moved through Godly wisdom and commands from Proverbs, and into the Parable of the Sower. Currently, this class is focusing on our blessings from the Lord. The second quarter, which will run through late November, will feature helpful people in the Bible, which lessons do not usually cover, and a study on the book of Philippians.

Preschool classes also began the new season with a series of lessons covering some of the best known miracles performed during Jesus' ministry. Youngsters then learned about interesting and special men and women of the New Testament. They have recently concluded studying the life of Joseph, learning how important it is to trust and follow the Lord in all circumstances. This class, too, will learn about helpers in the bible and hear stories from the book of Philippians.




