Dear Village Church Family and Friends,

Last Sunday, I announced that I will be on sabbatical for the month of October this year, and September and October next year. I'm writing this letter to explain what that means for me and for our congregation.

The word, "sabbatical" is related to the word "sabbath," which is an Old Testament word that means "stopping" or "ceasing" (the Sabbath day is literally, "Stop Day"). Throughout the Old Testament Law, God's people were commanded to stop and rest. A pattern formed of stopping every 7 days, 7 years, and 7x7 years. Sabbath and sabbatical are times for intentional rest, refocus, and reconnection with God. After the last few years with the pandemic and life in general, I find myself in need of all three of these. My plan for this October is to rest, to spend time in prayer, in solitude, to hike, to journal, and to read. My goal is rest for my body and my soul, and reconnection with God, my family, and myself.

While I am away, Pastor Tony Conragan will be covering all of the pastoral duties at our church. He will be preaching a sermon series on the Book of Nehemiah and available to counsel with those in need. Various Session elders will be attending staff meetings and available to assist with administrative needs that may arise. I have full confidence in the staff and elders to be able to handle the needs of our church.

I cannot say enough how grateful I am for this opportunity to rest and recharge and I know it is a gift. Thank you!





VILLAGE CHURCH MISSIONS



Background: We have been supporting missionaries Drew and Linka Parlee as a church for many years. In 2014, GEM assigned Drew to Third Millennium Ministries (https://thirdmill.org/) where he uses his Ph.D. and M.Div. to review and write free online seminary courses for pastors and lay people who cannot afford traditional seminary education. Although they now live in California, God is using Drew's work to reach more of the world than ever before. His seminary courses are translated into several major languages, so they're used wherever English, Spanish, Chinese, Russian and Arabic

are spoken - languages which represent 42% of the world's population. Both of them also make disciples locally in California.

From Drew:

Dear Brothers and Sisters of the Village Church,

Thank you for praying! Drew's heart 'surgery' on May 26 was successful. The 'surgery' was so minimally invasive that it is technically called a "procedure" rather than 'surgery.' On the very day of the procedure, my heartbeat returned to normal! I was able to return to work immediately! After three months of recovery, I can now climb hills without stopping to rest. After a follow-up appointment on August 23, the doctor will decide which heart medications I may reduce or even stop taking. Praise our Lord for the blessing of living in a day and culture where such a procedure is available.

I'm now preparing to teach three online Thirdmill Seminary courses that I've taught before.

Aug 15 – Oct 9, 2022. Building Your Theology. An introduction to 'theology.' Theology' is rightly interpreting the Bible and applying it to our minds, passions, and practices. My students include pastors, missionaries, church planters, and lay people from the Ukraine, where war continues, a hostile Islamic country, a hostile communist country, and from Burundi and Haiti - two of the poorest countries on earth.

Oct 17 - Dec 11, 2022. The Apostle's Creed. Basic beliefs that unite all Christians through the ages.

Jan 9 – Mar 5, 2023. What is Man? Adam and Eve were created by God in his image or likeness. Then they became corrupted by sin. This explains their need and our need for a savior from God.

Preparing to teach includes assigning some new required reading, updating homework, and writing down my latest ongoing dialogues with Jehovah's Witnesses to train pastors, future pastors, and missionaries to rightly interpret and not wrongly interpret the Bible.

Last week, a new Thirdmill Institute learning community started in Kiev, Ukraine – during the war!


