Dear Village Church Family and Friends,

The word, "sabbatical" is related to the word "sabbath," which is an Old Testament word that means "stopping" or "ceasing" (the Sabbath day is literally, "Stop Day"). Throughout the Old Testament Law, God's people were commanded to stop and rest. A pattern formed of stopping every 7 days, 7 years, and 7x7 years. Sabbath and sabbatical are times for intentional rest, reflection, refocus, and reconnection with God.

As I prepare to leave for sabbatical over the next two months, I've been reflecting on my life and work. This month marks 9 years that I have served as pastor here at The Village Church. This year marks 20 years since I was ordained to ministry. All of my children have graduated high school. Vicki and I will have been married 25 years this month as well. Through it all, God has been incredibly good to us and provided for us. My plan for this sabbatical time is to rest, to travel, to journal, and to read. My goal is to rest and to enrich my soul, and connect with God, my family, and myself.








VILLAGE CHURCH MISSIONS



The ministry of Salvation Army, Reno was last featured in The Village Church newsletter in June 2021. That was during the COVID pandemic, and the ministry found itself with many first-time applicants for services and an increased number of single moms who had previously been able to make ends meet, but with the cutbacks in employment, found they needed to reach out for help. The Salvation Army's mission is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in His name without discrimination – and they work diligently to provide social services such as utility, rental and shelter assistance, a food pantry, clothing and furniture vouchers, as well as dental, vision and prescription programs to those in need. They also operate an adult rehabilitation program for men ages 18-62. The 26-week program has 70 beds available and is offered free of charge.

Join us for worship at the 10AM service on Sunday, September 10th, and listen to Major Randy Hartt and Donna Ruiz update our congregation on their ministry in the Reno/Sparks area.

Founded in 1865, The Salvation Army, an international movement, is an evangelical part of the universal Christian Church. Its message is based on the Bible. Its ministry is motivated by the love of God. Its mission is They help approximately 23 million Americans annually and serve in 130 countries around the globe.

The Reno Corps of the Salvation Army works to fulfill the mission of the greater organization from their headquarters on Sutro Street in Reno. The local organization also responds when tragedy strikes by providing emergency disaster services. Whether it is a house fire, or a natural disaster on a greater scale, the Salvation Army is there to provide for physical needs and offer emotional support. Every Sunday there is a worship service offered at their location.

Funding for the Reno Corps comes not only from the familiar "red kettle" drive during Christmas season and donors like The Village Church, they have three thrift stores in the Reno/Carson City area. Proceeds from the thrift stores fund the rehabilitation program, and the men in the program receive work therapy by picking up donations and preparing them for sale.

The need is great in the Reno/Sparks area for all of the services provided by the Reno Corps of The Salvation Army. The Village Church Missions Committee is grateful to have the resources to support their ministry. Please keep their employees and those they serve in your prayers.


